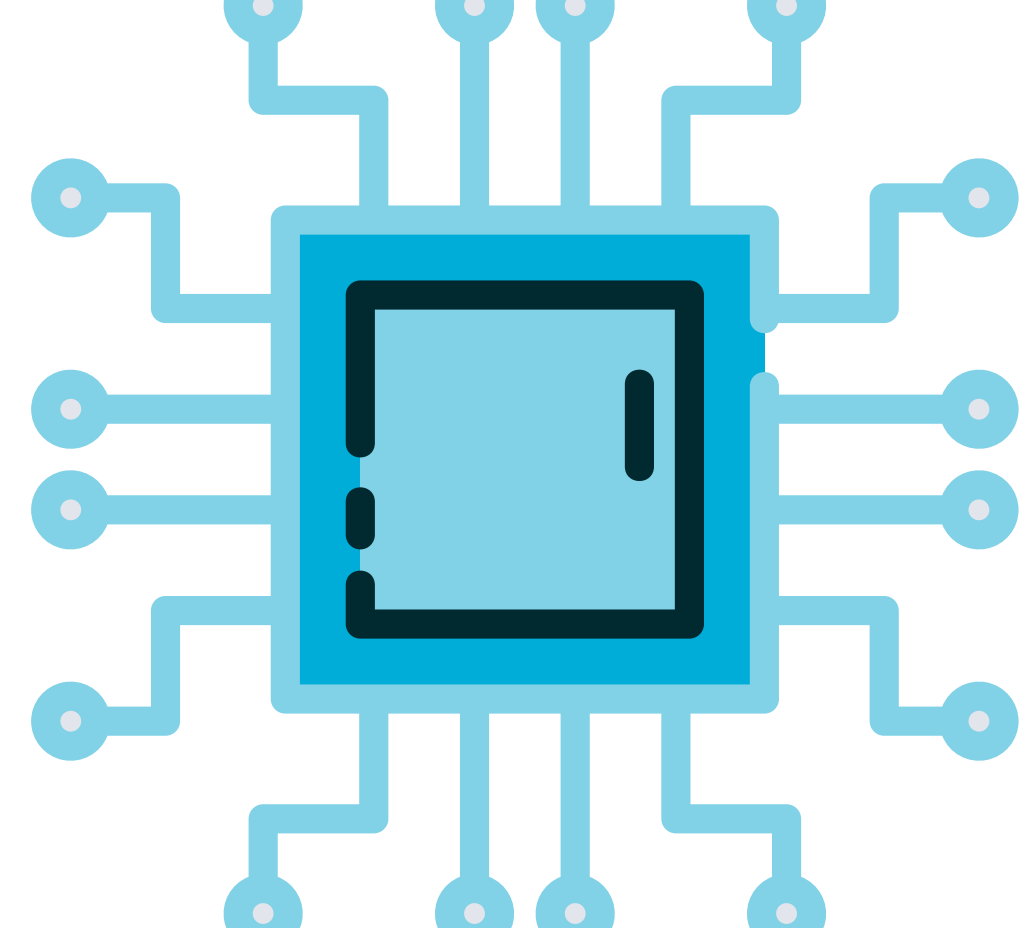


2. Safe cities with low crime rates

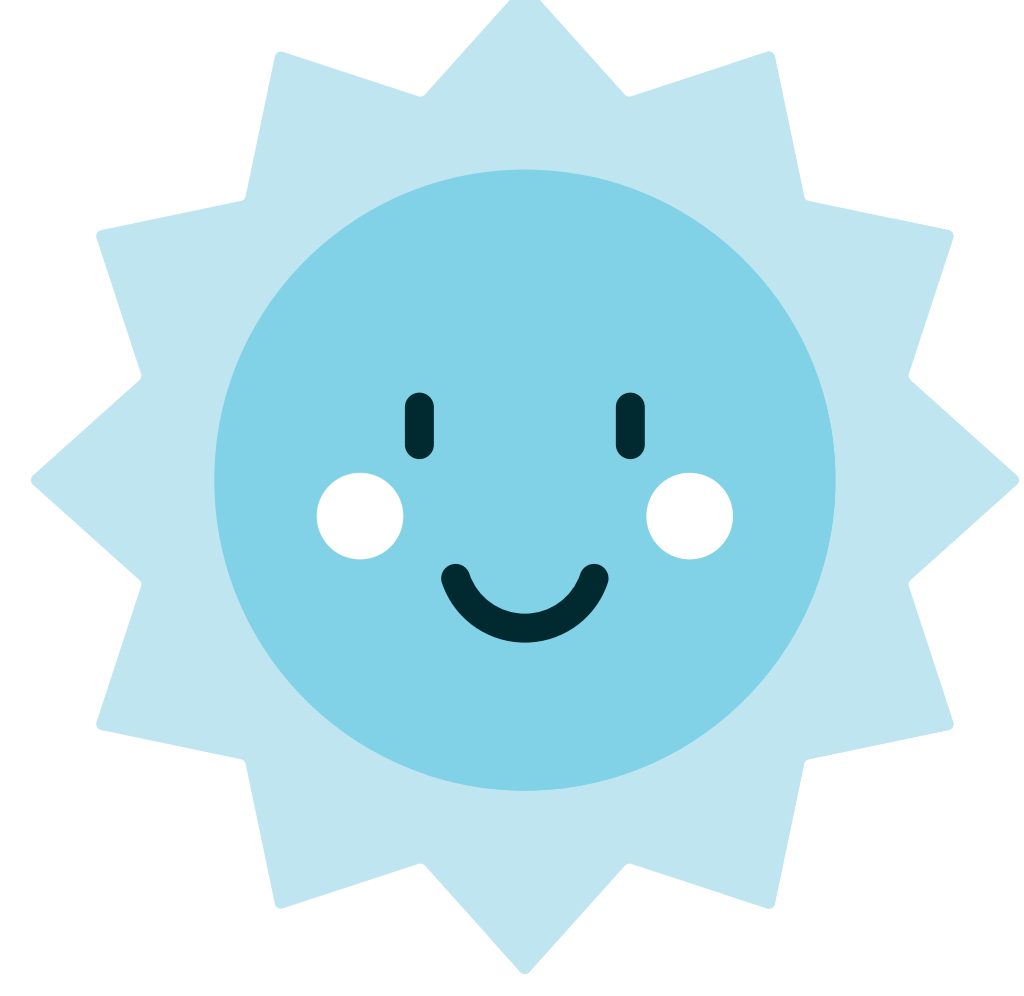


4. Digital growth is just beginning and is about to explode!

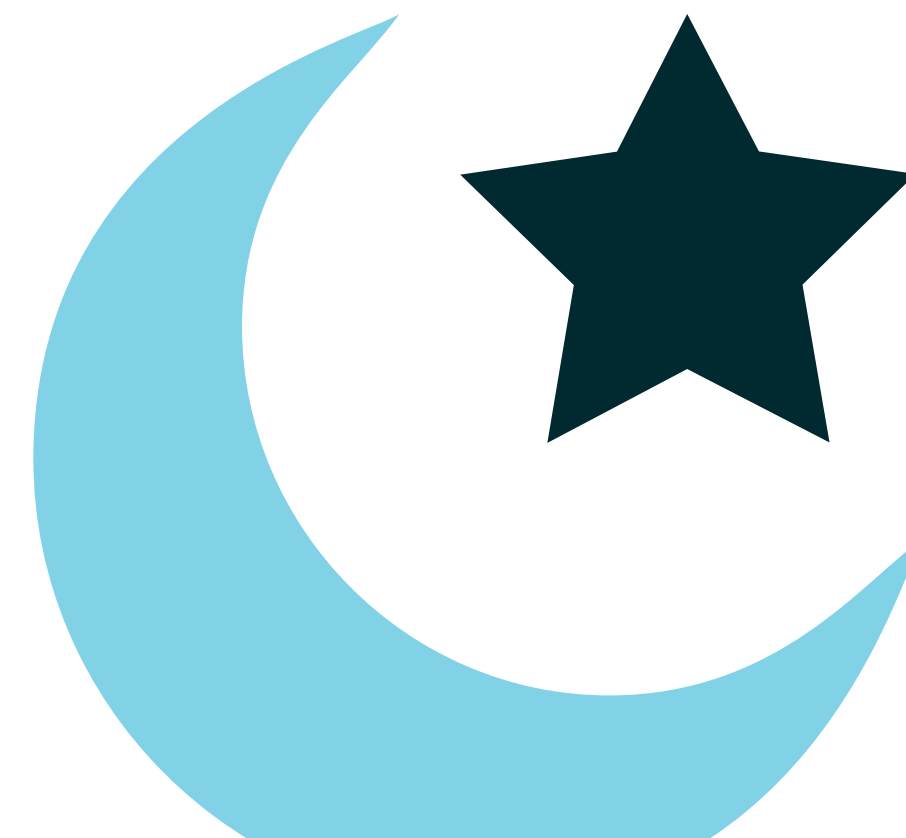


6. Good weather all year round
